As of January 15, 2010, PRNIndiana will be using Witham Laboratories for all client testing. Witham has been accredited by the Joint Commission, the College of American Pathologists, and the CMS Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services. Witham specializes in testing for Witham Hospital and government agencies including physicians, nurses, lawyers, judges and the Indiana Corrections system that have impaired individuals. For your convenience, Witham will partner with a collection site near your home or work.

After signing a PRNIndiana aftercare contract, it is your responsibility to contact Ms. Smock at Witham within 10 days (see phone number above). The PRNIndiana office makes an initial call to Witham giving them your contact information so they can begin setting up your account for UDS. After your call, and confirmation of the information and payment procedures, Witham will be sending a packet with forms to sign and as stated above, will coordinate or partner with a collection site generally within 25 miles of your home or work. Setup usually takes 7 to 10 business days. Witham will confirm when you should begin calling into the system.

You are required to call a toll-free number (866) 483-1569 for a random selection system, Monday thru Sunday (7 days a week), to learn if you are to test that day. You must call between **5 am and 5 pm or it will be considered a missed call-in**. In addition, you must go to your designated collection site before closing of the business day to be screened. Make sure you know the hours of operation of collection site, noting any holiday hours or make a call during bad weather.

The results of your testing will be available 7 to 10 days after the screening from the PRNIndiana office and copies will be sent to you for your files at beginning of the next month after testing. All Indiana State Pharmacy Board Ordered clients results will be sent to the state board before the monthly board meeting, but if you are board ordered, your compliance materials for your probationary appearance should include copies of results.

Both the PRN office and the MRO receive copies of your results from Witham. All test results are reviewed by the MRO. You will be called if the results are positive, which means you are in non-compliance of your contract.
